## Proven success:

In Stoke-on-Trent, 73.6% of young people were classified as 'not known'. 18 months later that figure had reduced to just 1.7%.



During 2024–25, Wakefield's performance was ranked in quintile 2, placing it within the top **35**% of Local Authorities nationally.
